Principal's Report

- putting some money towards the use of SeeSaw—a communication app used by the school (the price per student has increased over the past 4 years).
- the installation of a communication board (used by students to communicate needs).

Gibson Neill received 22% passing rate for Numeracy.

The school will look at how tardiness and absenteeism has affected this, in addition to having a school improvement goal focused on improvement in numeracy.

The PSSC has expressed an interest in supporting these efforts. One idea is to identify and share parent-friendly resources with families about the importance of school, arriving on time, and ways to help children be ready to learn.

The PSSC will discuss spending of the \$1000 budget, and also continue the discussion around ways to support improving tardiness and absenteeism.
