-Data / leadership team will look the data from the teacher surveys completed this month and determine at next steps going forward in the school plan.

-Admin team noticed a decrease in behavior in December from previous months.

Enrollment-

Currently at 689 students

Currently over the maximum class size according to collective agreement in grade 2 Prime. There will be an additional teacher hired in a teach teaching situation to address this over the next week. The Immigration process seems to be opening up again and we are expecting an increase in newcomer students this winter.

Public Meeting Recap

-Final catchment area decided will be decided late March, as of right now Marysville and Penniac will remain at Gibson-Neill and those living in the Devon area will go to new Cuffman Street School. Students residing in the Saint Mary's Community will continue to attend Gibson-Neill if they choose not to attend their community school, Chief Harold Sappier.

-Hiring for Principal will be held shortly and named in the near future.
