Bus Driver Recruitment and Retention

Gibson Neill PSSC would like to do what it can do to support the recruitment and retention of bus drivers; this could be an area we look at spending our remaining budget

-Tracy will reach out to the Superintendent and Transportation to see what we as a PSSC can do to support these efforts in addition to seeing if we can access any data on the number of students who have been affected by cancelled bus runs in September and October of this year. If Tracy is able to get the data, she will bring it to the November meeting for PSSC to review and discuss.

With the change of the K-2 day and the extra FTE received by schools, Gibson Neill has added to their staffing a teacher whose role is titled "Exploration Teacher." This teaching role explores different learning opportunities in a hands-on, inquiry-based way. Learning opportunities will be focused on the following: outdoor learning, problem solving, STEAM (high-tech and low-tech), digital citizenship and other areas in the Explore Your World and Personal Wellness curricular areas. Each classroom receives this class once a week.

Principal's Report

The school has two school improvement goals for the 2024-2025 school year one on academic and one on social-emotional well-being

Goal 1: Using Formative assessment to drive explicit whole class instruction, so that 100% of students make improvements in a specified skill in literacy and numeracy

-Working towards common assessment and using student academic data to drive teaching focus and interventions through monthly PLC meetings and teacher collaboration.

Goal 2: To improve positive school behavior that results in 5% or less of students each month receiving student incident reports. Also looking to decrease negative behaviors: defiance, disrespect, inappropriate language, and physical violence

Steps taken to meet this goal have included:

Creation of a Behavior Matrix that shows what expected behaviors look like and sound like for both staff and students. Staff have taught, modelled and will continue to reinforce whenever needed throughout the year. The Behavior Matrix is personalized to and based on our code of conduct of: "Be Respectful, Safe, and Kind.
